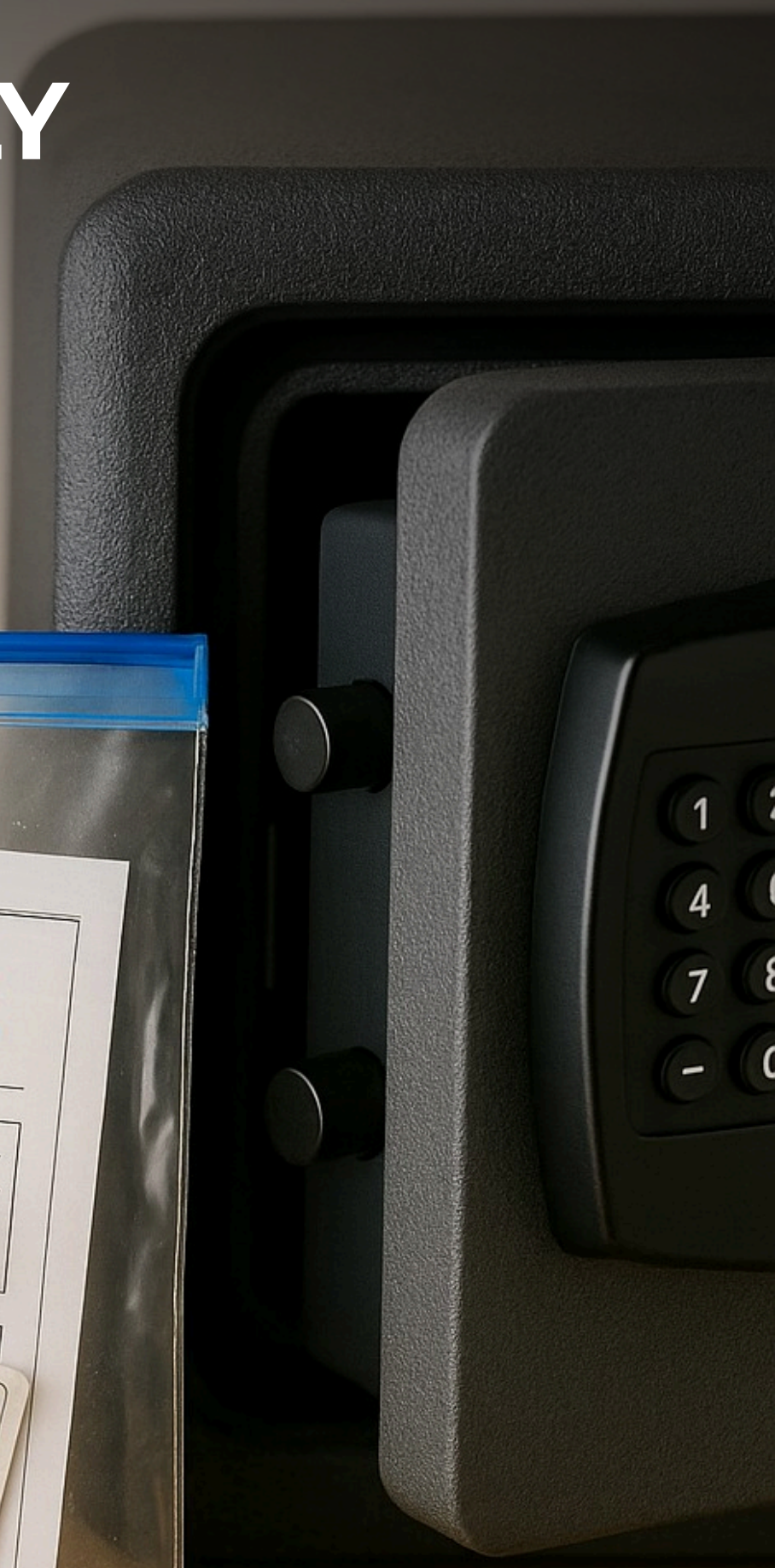
# ESSENTIALS TO HAVE READY

- First Aid Kit: Bandages, antiseptics, pain relievers, allergy meds.
- Non-Perishable Food & Water: 3–7 days' worth per person.
- Medications: 7-day supply of prescriptions + OTC.
- Flashlights & Batteries: Avoid candles. Include headlamps and power banks.
- Phone Chargers: Solar-powered or portable battery backups.



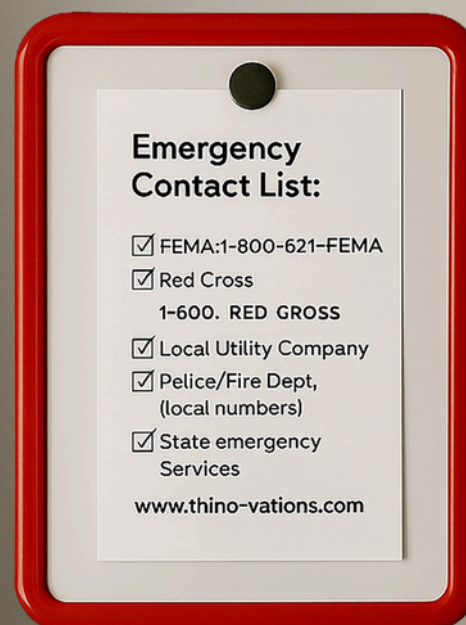
# IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS STORE SECURELY

- Insurance policies, ID, property deeds, medical info.
- Place in a waterproof bag or fire-safe box.
- Digitally back up on cloud or USB drive.

- Local Utility Company
- Police/Fire Dept. (local numbers)
- State Emergency Services
- Add 2–3 trusted local contractors or roofers,

# HOME READINESS CHECKLIST

- Trim trees & secure loose objects.
- Check the roof for missing shingles.
- Clean gutters & downspouts.
- Install storm shutters or board windows.
- Know evacuation routes & shelters.



# ROOFING READINESS TIPS

Your roof is your home's shield against severe weather. Checking it before the storm can prevent serious damage and expensive repairs later.

- Inspect for missing or damaged shingles.
- Check flashing around vents and chimneys.
- Clear gutters and downspouts to prevent water buildup.
- Secure loose roof tiles or materials.

# TAKE PHOTOS: BEFORE & AFTER

- Exterior: Roof, siding, windows, doors, fences.
- Interior: Ceilings, walls, flooring, appliances, valuables.
- Date-stamp or use apps with time tracking.



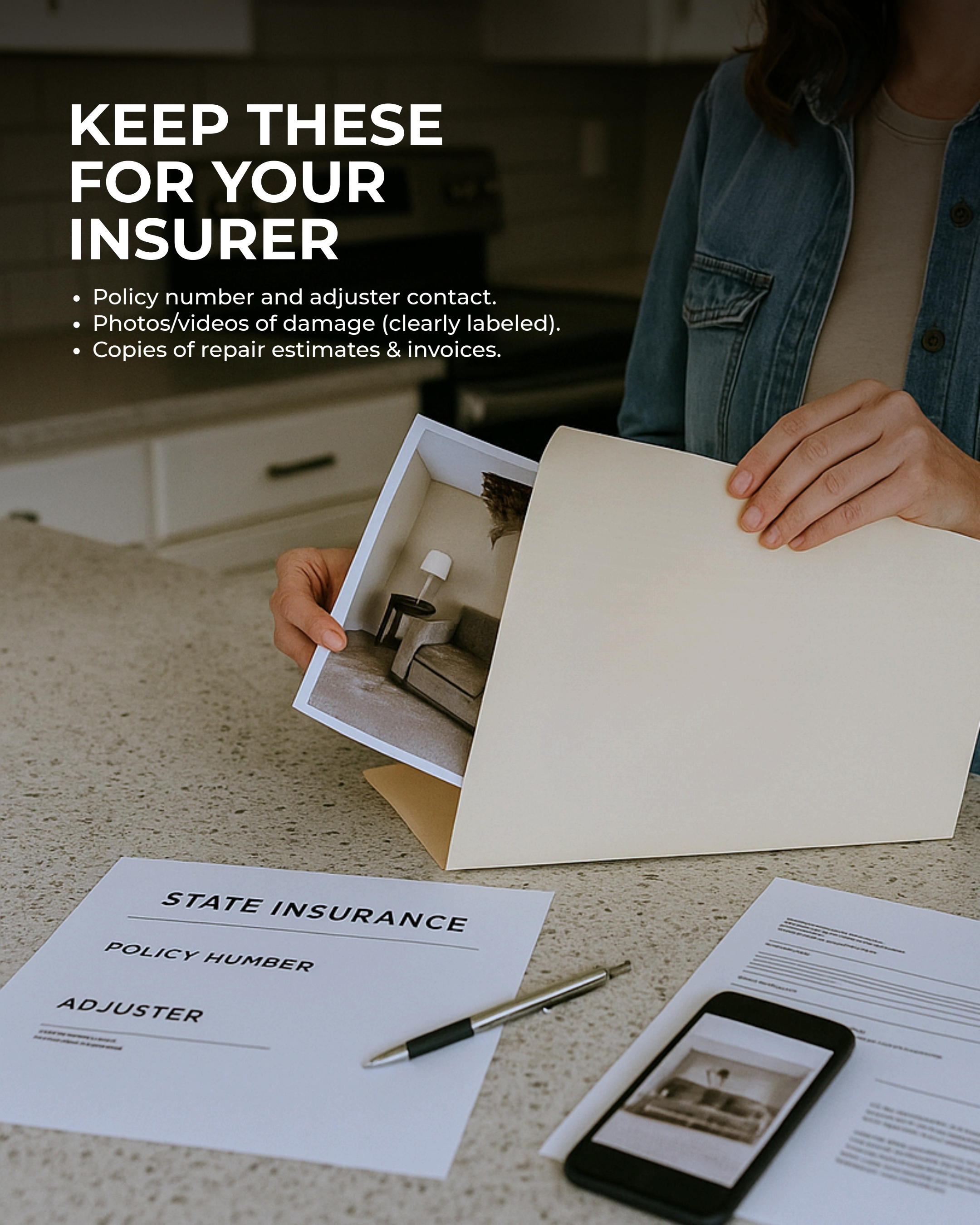
# DOCUMENT EVERYTHING

Inventory of damaged items.  
Save receipts from temporary repairs or  
hotel stays.  
Write down dates & times of damage  
observed.



# KEEP THESE FOR YOUR INSURER

- Policy number and adjuster contact.
- Photos/videos of damage (clearly labeled).
- Copies of repair estimates & invoices.





# AVOID THESE MISTAKES

Don't delay contacting your insurance.  
Don't discard damaged items before documentation.  
Don't make major repairs before inspection.

# ROOFING DAMAGE TIPS

Signs of Possible Damage:  
Missing shingles or visible holes.  
Water spots or damp patches on ceilings.  
Dripping sounds during or after rain.  
Sagging areas on the roofline.

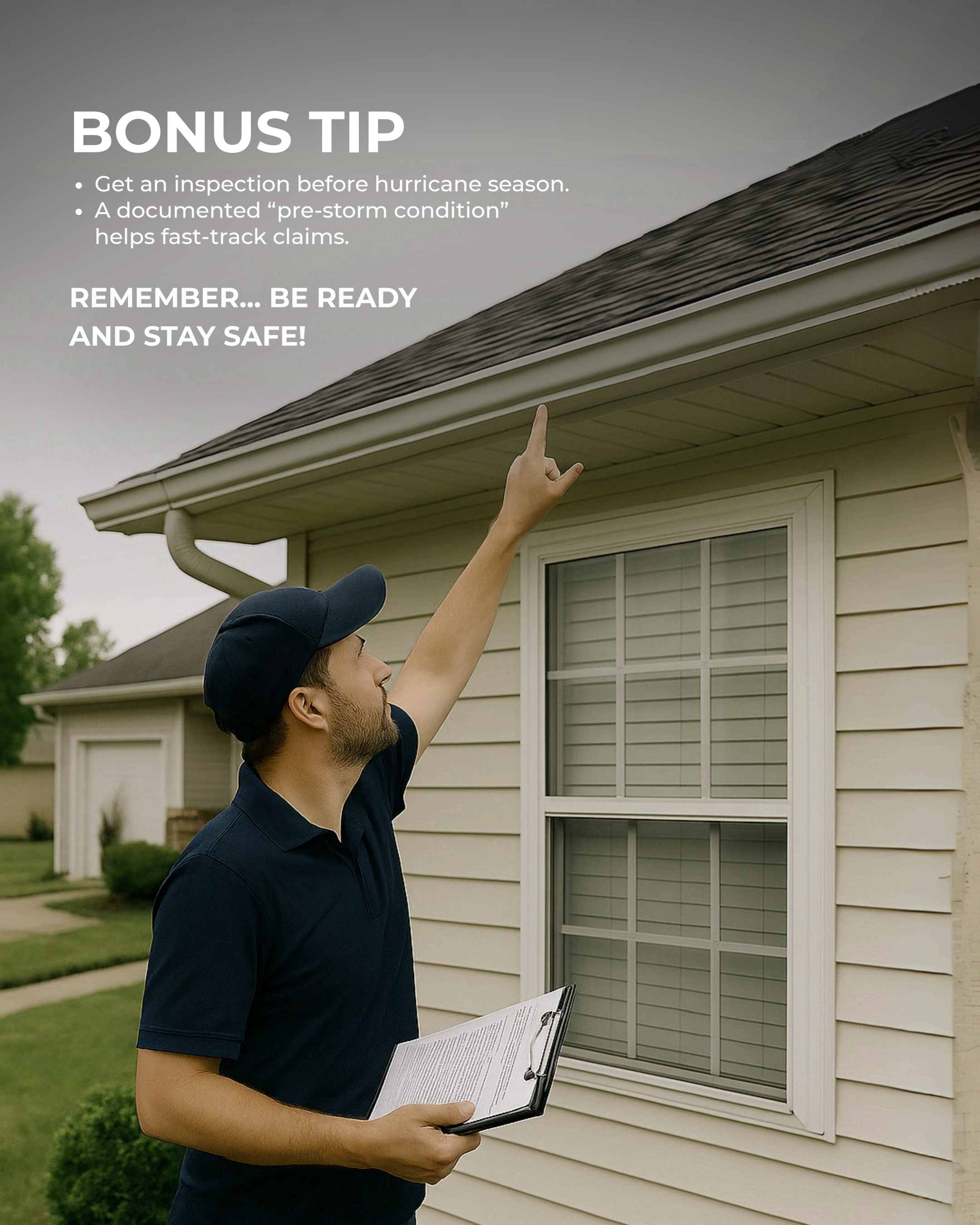
If you see leaks or damage:  
Avoid wet ceilings or damaged roofs—they may collapse.  
Never climb on the roof—it's unsafe after a storm.  
Contact us immediately or wait for our call to arrange a safe inspection  
and repairs.



# BONUS TIP

- Get an inspection before hurricane season.
- A documented “pre-storm condition” helps fast-track claims.
